



Homework Policy

Purpose

This policy outlines the expectations for homework across grade levels to enhance student learning while considering their developmental needs.

Homework Guidelines

Grades K-4

- **No Mandatory Homework:** Homework will not be required for students in grades K-4.
- **Skills-Based Reinforcement Activities:** Optional activities may be provided to reinforce skills learned in class, but participation will not be graded or mandated.

Grade 5

- **Bi-Weekly Homework Packets:** Students will receive homework packets every two weeks that include assignments in English Language Arts (ELA) and Math.
 - **Effort Grade:** Completion of these packets will contribute to the student's effort grade.
 - **Skills-Based Reinforcement Activities:** Assignments will focus on reinforcing essential skills and concepts.

Grades 6-8

- **Cross-Subject Project:** Students will complete one cross-subject project per trimester that integrates learning across various subjects.
 - **Skills-Based Reinforcement Activities:** Projects will encourage the application of skills learned in class and foster collaborative learning.

Responsibilities

- Teachers will provide clear instructions and expectations for homework assignments and projects.
- Parents/guardians are encouraged to support their children in completing homework while promoting independence and time management skills.
- Students are expected to complete and submit assignments on time to ensure a productive learning environment.
